The original Home started by the Rebekahs and Odd Fellows so many years ago has grown exponentially from a small home for orphans to a state of the art facility for Seniors.

The Corporation Board of Directors includes Members from the Grand Lodge and the Rebekah Assembly of Ontario, continuing our contribution to the operation of this Home. Residents come from all over Ontario and there are many members from our Order who are residents at this time. Funding for capital projects such

as new purchases and replacements for equipment continue to be a major need and are not funded by the Government.

A MAJOR Capital Project is currently being worked on with the redevelopment of the Home for the Phase Two and Phase Three Expansions. Monies from the Government are not available for the necessary redevelopment (which totals millions of dollars) and it is the generous donations of Lodges, Members and sponsors that will make this redevelopment a reality.

The Report from the Home, that appears in the Journal of Proceedings, details each year what is needed and where funds were appropriated. The IOOF Seniors Homes INC is most grateful for any donations that your Lodge can make to help cover these costs.

Each year this committee works closely with the Directors and Doctors of the Eye Bank of Canada, Ontario division. Our Order has been a continuing sponsor of a Research Grant and a Student Bursary as well as providing funds to purchase capital equipment that has been placed on the Eye Bank "Wish List".

We have purchased many pieces of equipment over the years. Recent purchases included a much needed specialized microscope, Medallions for the families of those donating eyes to the eye bank, an Autoclave for Cornea Re-Sectioning, a Pachymeter for testing Glaucoma in patients and most recently a special freezer unit to preserve Amniotic Membranes for future use in eye surgery.

Christine Humphreys, Manager of the Eye Bank of Canada is more than happy to come to your Lodge to give a presentation on the Eye Bank and required donations.
