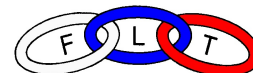

The Allan Simpson Educational Fund was established in May 2002 to assist with the costs of post secondary education for young people who are full orphans (both parents deceased).

To date we have provided awards to an average of 6 students per year.

Mr Allan Simpson was born in Ontario and was orphaned as a child. He was raised in an orphanage that was owned and maintained by the Independent Order of Odd Fellows in Ontario.

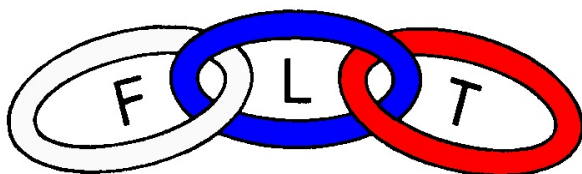
He emigrated to the United States after World War II and had been employed as a merchant seaman. He died after a lengthy illness on August 27, 1995. His bequest of funds to the Grand Lodge of Ontario, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, upon his death, was made to express his considerable gratitude and loyalty toward the Order.

The Annual Awards are available to qualified applicants in their quest for a post secondary education and are renewable if the applicant maintains a passing grade in all courses as a full time student at a University or College.

The Grand Lodge of Ontario at its Annual Session in 2024 further expanded the eligibility requirements due to decreasing numbers of applications from "full orphans". "Full Orphans" both parents being deceased, with preference being given to full orphans of deceased Odd Fellows Lodge / Rebekah Lodge members, and, second, to applicants of a single parent home with preference being given to those with living Odd Fellows Lodge / Rebekah Lodge Members, and third, to applicants of a single parent home with no Odd Fellows Lodge attachment.

The number and amount of awards each year are subject to the interest earned by the Fund. The awards will be disbursed in two installments, payable to the University/College, and credited to the student's account.. The first half will be mailed after the student provides confirmation of registration as a full time student for the Fall Semester and the remainder will be mailed when the student provides proof of registration for the Winter Semester and a transcript for the Fall Semester show passing grades in all courses. The Awards are renewable in subsequent years at the discretion of the Selection Committee.

Application Forms must be submitted no later than March 1st of each year. Any questions can be addressed to the undersigned at the above mailing or email address.

The Awards are renewable at the discretion of the Awards Committee if a passing average is maintained. The amount of the awards will be announced annually.
